**A**UTOMATION — use of automatic machinery in production — has alarmed some people, who imagine “robotic factories” as a result. But although automation is a new word, the principle is ancient.

Every tool invented by man to relieve drudgery and increase output, from the wheel and the plow to modern machines and assembly lines, is a form of automation.

Mechanical progress not only has enriched our lives, but always makes more jobs and more opportunities.

For example, in 1880, when mechanical power supplied only 17% of work energy, 34% of our population had jobs. By 1900, when power provided 64% of work energy, 50% of the population were employed. And in 1954, with 99% of work energy supplied by power, 58% of us had jobs.

There are always people who fear progress, but the usual record — use of more jobs, of new industries born, of better living — has proved their fears to be groundless. Automation is one more forward step.
