Zeros Are Harmless — It's Figure In Front That Does Damage

Maybe everyone will agree that a family handling its finances on this basis is headed for serious trouble.

So, add zeros—zeros to these figures—and you have the exact fiscal situation of the government under the Kennedy administration.¹

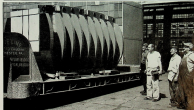
