1. Artifacts's Record:

1.1: This 'Service and Loyalty' article was published in 'Our Yard's' first magazine issue of September 1941. This was also the first article SSHS has in it's archives pertaining to service awards.

SSHS: 705 4109-18

"Early last year the Board of Directors of our Company authorized the presentation of a service and loyalty emblem to all employees who have had accumulated service of ten or more years and are still in the service of the Company. These emblems are small gold pins, with blue lettering showing the length of service of the employee to whom it is awarded, in accordance with the following schedule:

- -10 Years-plain gold emblem
- -15 Years-plain gold emblem
- -20 years-gold emblem- 1 sapphire
- -25 years-gold emblem- 2 sapphires
- -30 years-gold emblem- 3 sapphires
- -35 years-gold emblem- 4 sapphires
- -40 years-gold emblem- 5 sapphires
- -45 years-gold emblem- 4 diamonds
- -50 years-gold emblem- 5 diamonds"

"First 50-Year Pin went to Pete Esrey..."

Sun Ship records show that David R. 'Pete' Esrey started at the Wetherill plant in 1886. Sun Ship came into being in 1916 and acquired the Wetherill Plant in the same year. Employees that transitioned to Sun Ship maintained their seniority... 'Pete' Esery was awarded his 50 Year Service Award in 1936 and his last day working at the Wetherill plant was Jan. 20, 1940. He passed away 4 days later with 64 years of service.

-35 Years Two 6-Point Diamonds

One Blue Sapphire

-40 Years Three 6-Point Diamonds"

"The new award, which is used to recognize and honor the shipyard's many long-term employees, will have its initial distribution in July 1978. Years of service are indicated by a variety of combinations of sapphires and diamonds."
