Internal Sun Ship Calls — To dial any Sun Ship extension listed in this directory, listen for dial tone and dial the extension number. Telephone numbers beginning with 2, 3, or certain 83 numbers can be used only for in-plant calls (Shipyard, Wetherill, and/or Annex).

LONG DISTANCE CALLS —

From 8300 thru 8319 and 8800 series telephone extensions, dial "9" then the number.

From 400, 500, 600 & 700 series telephone extensions, dial "0" and give number to operator and operator will place the call immediately, station-to-station. After switchboard is closed, dial 283 or 8383 and the guard will place the call for you.

Conference Calls - Conference call facilities are available over the SUNCOM Network and over the regular public telephone network. To place a conference call, dial "O" and give the Operator all of the necessary information, including names and telephone numbers of those to be included in the conference.

Transferring Calls - Incoming calls (excluding SUNCOM calls) may be transferred from one extension to another. To do this, depress the receiver switchhook ONE TIME - SLOWLY. When the operator comes on the line, give her the extension number to which the call is to be transferred and hang up. The operator will complete the transfer.

Personal Calls - Pay telephones are located conveniently for employees in the office and in the yard. Check with your supervisor for full details on procedure.

Switchboard Hours - Operators are on duty from 7:45 AM to 5:30 PM daily except weekends and holidays.
