"The S. S. 'Atlantic Refiner' will be christened Friday at approximately 6:27 P.M. Mrs. Nellis M. Glossop, wife of William Glossop, foreman of the Pattern Shop at the Wetherill plant, will sponsor the vessel. Glossop is one of the oldest employees of the company, having served for 47 years and one month.

5. S.S. 'Atlantic Refiner' Tanker Model Donation


5.1: The Sun Ship Historical Society was contacted by Pamela Croasdale in October of 2023 to see if we would be interested in acquiring a model of a T2-Sun Ship built tanker that her father arranged to have built.

Partial text from Pamela's donation letter read: "I have a beautiful ship – It is the *Atlantic Refiner*. My father sailed on this, the *(Atlantic) Dealer*, the *(Atlantic) Trader* and *the EJ Henry*, but the *(Atlantic) Refiner* was his favorite ship. Information about this ship is below. My father had this built."

As previously stated, her father, Robert M. Croasdale started as a seaman for the Atlantic Refining Company in 1952. During that time, he had worked in ship's engine rooms. He went into the Army c:1955, returning to Atlantic Refining from 1958-1960. Three of the ships that Robert had worked on were built by Sun Ship included ; '*Atlantic Refiner*' Hull-488, '*Atlantic Trader*' Hull-475 and the '*E.J. Henry*' Hull-181.
